	M	Acacia acinacea	Gold dust wattle	Golden ball flowers during spring
	M	Acacia dealbata	Silver wattle	Grey, fernlike foliage, yellow flowers in spring
	S	Acacia exudans (verniciiflua)	Casterton Wattle	Slightly aromatic, dense rounded shrub
	M	Acacia implexa	Lightwood	Medium tree with curved foliage and pale yellow flowers in summer, well-drained soils, tolerates dryness
	M	Acacia mearnsii	Black Wattle	Medium tree, green fern-like foliage, creamy yellow flowers in spring to summer
	M	Acacia melanoxylon	Blackwood	Upright tree, 8-10m with deep green large leaves, heavy canopy, cream flowers July - Oct
	S	Acacia paradoxa	Hedge Wattle	Prickly shrub 2-3m, gold ball flowers in spring, tolerates dryness
	M	Acacia provincialis (retinodes)	Swamp Wattle/ Wirilda	Medium fast-growing tree, grey- green foliage, bright yellow flowers blooming throughout the year. Tolerates drought, salt
	M	Acacia pycnantha	Golden Wattle	Spreading small tree, golden flowers in spring. Most soils, tolerates dryness
	S	Acacia verticillata	Prickly Moses	Hardy open medium shrub, lemon flowers from winter to summer
	S	Allocasuarina muelleriana	Slaty She-oak	Dense medium – tall shrub, grey foliage, tolerates drought
	S	Allocasuarina paludosa	Scrub She-oak	Small bushy compact shrub to 1.5m
	M	Allocasuarina verticillata	Drooping She-oak	Small to medium tree, dark green drooping foliage
	M	Banksia marginata	Silver banksia	Medium tree, attractive foliage, cones of yellow flowers in Autumn and winter, most soils
	S	Bursaria spinosa	Sweet bursaria	Small to medium shrub, 5-10m, white flowers in spring/summer,
	S	Callistemon citrinus	Crimson Bottlebrush	Bushy shrub bright red flowers
	S	Callistemon rugulosus	Scarlet Bottlebrush	Bushy shrub, red bottlebrush flowers in spring, any soil
	M	Callistemon sieberi	River Bottlebrush	Medium shrub with fine sharp leaves, yellow bottlebrush flowers during spring and autumn
	G	Carex appressa	Tall Sedge	Grass-like hardy sedge, will grow well in damp areas and tolerate dry areas with low summer rainfall

	T	Casuarina cunninghamiana	River She-oak	Tall tree, dark green drooping foliage
	M	Casuarina obesa	Swamp She-oak (Vic)	Tree, found in Wimmera near salt lakes
	M	Chamaecytisus palmensis	Tree Lucerne	Small spreading evergreen tree that grows 3-4m, stock feed
	T	Corymbia citriodora	Lemon Scented Gum	Large tree with smooth pale aromatic bark and leaves
	M	Corymbia ficifolia	Red Flowering Gum	Medium tree, striking flower
	T	Corymbia maculata	Spotted Gum	Medium to very tall forest tree
	S	Dodonaea viscosa	Hop Bush	Medium to tall shrub with sticky green leaves and large hop-like fruits turning red
	S	Dodonaea viscosa cuneata	Wedge-Leaf Hop-Bush	Spreading shrub, widespread in inland, red seed capsules
	M	Eucalyptus arenacea	Desert Stringybark	Desert tree or mallee to 10 m tall
	M	Eucalyptus aromaphloia	Scent Bark Gum	Small to medium tree
	L	Eucalyptus baxteri	Brown stringy bark	Medium to tall, white flowers in late summer, brown fibrous bark
	T	Eucalyptus botryoides	Southern mahogany	Tall tree with rough bark, flowers in February
	T	Eucalyptus camaldulensis	Red gum	Large open spreading or tall tree
	T	Eucalyptus cladocalyx*	Sugar Gum	Tall tree, spreading crown, white flowers in summer
	M	Eucalyptus cladocalyx nana	Dwarf sugar gum	Multi-stemmed, stout medium tree, creamy flowers in spring/summer
	T	Eucalyptus globulus	Blue Gum	Large tree, flowers Nov-Dec
	M	Eucalyptus goniocalyx	Long-Leaf Box	Small/medium tree, crooked trunk
	M	Eucalyptus kitsoniana	Bog Gum	Small to large mallee or woodland tree

	G	<i>Juncus kraussii</i>	Salt Marsh Rush	Large, rigid, clumping forming perennial herb
	G	<i>Juncus procerus</i>	Tall Rush	Dense, robust tufted perennial rush
	S	<i>Kunzea baxteri</i>	Scarlet Kunzea	Rounded shrub, bottlebrush-like red flowers winter to summer
	S	<i>Leptospermum continentale</i>	Prickly tea tree	Straggling shrub or small tree
	m	<i>Leptospermum lanigerum</i>	Woolly Tea Tree	Dense shrub to small tree for wet areas
	S	<i>Leptospermum obovatum</i>	River tea tree	Dense erect shrub
	S/M	<i>Leptospermum polygalifolium</i>	Yellow Teatree	Shrub or tree, greenish to creamy white flowers
	S	<i>Leptospermum scoparium</i>	Broom Tea Tree	Shrub to small tree, good honey production
	M	<i>Melaleuca armillaris*</i>	Bracelet Honey Myrtle	Cream white flowers
	S/M	<i>Melaleuca decussata</i>	Totem Poles/ Cross-leaved Honey Myrtle	Medium shrub, mauve-pink flowers in spring/summer
	S	<i>Melaleuca gibbosa</i>	Slender Honey-myrtle	Wiry shrub, pink to purple flowers
	S/M	<i>Melaleuca halmaturorum*</i>	Salt Paperbark	Shrub to small tree, white flowers in spring. Useful for saline areas.
	M	<i>Melaleuca huegelii</i>	Chenille Honey Myrtle	Shrub or small tree with pink, white or purple flowers
	M	<i>Melaleuca lanceolata</i>	Moonah	Shrub or tree to 10 m high, white flowers in summer
	S	<i>Melaleuca squamea</i>	Swamp Honey-myrtle	Mostly low shrub, mauve flowers
	M	<i>Melaleuca squarrosa</i>	Scent Paperbark	Mostly shrubby but occasionally tall, cream flowers
	S	<i>Melaleuca wilsonii</i>	Wilson's honey myrtle	Narrow leaves, reddish pink flowers in spring
	G	<i>Microlaena stipoides</i>	Weeping Grass	Small perennial grass, elegant weeping seed head, good native lawn grass

	G	<i>Poa labillardierei</i>	Tussock Grass	Large densely tufted tussock
	G	<i>Rytidosperma caespitosum</i>	Wallaby Grass	Tufted perennial grass
